Re: Additional INSET day and early school closure notice

I am writing to you to advise you that Lymm High School will be closed for a Staff INSET day on Friday 17th June 2016 in order that teachers can prepare for new GCSE and A Level specifications. Students will therefore, not be required to attend school on this day, unless they have an external examination, which will be unaffected. School will re-open again at the normal time on Monday 20th June 2016.

Should the school closure pose any significant issues with child care we would be happy to support a small number of students throughout the day. If you feel this may be beneficial please do not hesitate to contact school and we will try our best to support you.

If a student, who is taking an examination on that day, can foresee any potential issues with the cancellation of the transport, please can they ensure that these are reported to the school immediately and we will put a plan in place to ensure that they are unaffected.

I would also like to remind you that the school will also be closing early on Thursday 16th June 2016, the afternoon before INSET, to prepare for the annual Summer Open Evening. Buses have been notified and will be available from 12.25pm to ensure a safe journey home. We hope many of our students will return in the evening to support prospective pupils and also to use this as an opportunity to gain further evidence for the Leadership Ladders. More details will be available closer to the time.
