## Re: GCSE Religious Studies Revision

As the exam season will be soon be upon us I am writing to you about the revision program we are offering at Lymm High School. Your son/daughter has two GCSE Religious Studies exams this summer:

- Religion and Life – 16<sup>th</sup> May 2016
- Religion and Society – 18 May 2016

To prepare your son/daughter for their GCSE Religious Studies exam, the Religious Studies department will be running extra revision sessions whereby they will be taken off timetable for two periods either on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> March or Monday 21<sup>st</sup> March depending on their population. Confirmation of which date for your child will be given via Twitter, the school website and text message. I will also confirm to your child directly through their RS lesson.

After the Easter break we will also hold an after school revision session to help prepare them closer to the actual exam. Date to follow.
