Dear Parent/Guardian,

I am delighted to be able to confirm the details for Lymm High School's Year 11 Prom 2017. What better way for your child to celebrate 11 years of school education, the end of their GCSE examinations and the start of a new chapter in their life, than to be with the class of 2017 as they party the night away for the last time together as Year 11 students.

The event is being held at <u>The Cresta Court, Altrincham</u>, on <u>Thursday 29th June 2017</u>. Arrival is for 6.30pm, with the meal being served at 7.00pm. The students will need to be collected at 10.30pm when the evening will finish. Students will be required to make their own way to and from the event and I strongly advise, if you are unable to collect your son/daughter and they require a taxi, that one is pre-ordered and that your son/daughter has all the details in case of any problems.

The programme for the evening is:

6.30pm Arrivals, Reception drinks
7.00pm Dinner to be served at tables
8.15pm Presentations and Speeches

8.30pm Disco 10.30pm Carriages

The bar will be open for students to purchase soft drinks only. We will be operating a strict no alcohol policy and searches will be conducted on entry. In addition, any students suspected of consuming alcohol prior to the event will be refused entry and parents will be asked to collect them.

A professional photographer will be there from 6.30pm for the evening to capture the magical memories. Individual and group photographs will be available to buy via the photographer's website. We will also have a Photobooth to capture more informal images throughout the evening.

The cost of a prom ticket will be £30.00 and will include a welcome drink, two course meal and a disco. Discount tickets will be available with up to 25% off for students who meet the highest standards when at school in the remaining weeks. 5% per week will be discounted for students who have 100% attendance for the week, do not have any late marks and avoid any detentions or behaviour points. Students need to apply for these discounts by submitting an online discount claim form (students to be informed of the process). Tickets will be available to reserve on parent pay from Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> June.
