I am delighted to be able to confirm the details for Lymm High School's Year 11 Prom 2019. The event is being held at **The Courthouse, Knutsford**, on **Thursday 27th June 2019**.

Arrival is for 6.30pm, with food being served at 7.00pm. The students will need to be collected at 10.00pm when the evening will finish. Students will be required to make their own way to and from the event and I strongly advise, if you are unable to collect your son/daughter and they require a taxi, that one is pre-ordered and that your son/daughter has all the details in case of any problems.

The programme for the evening is:

The bar will be open for students to purchase soft drinks only. We will be operating a strict no alcohol policy and searches will be conducted on entry. In addition, any students suspected of consuming alcohol prior to the event will be refused entry and parents will be asked to collect them.

A professional photographer will be there from 6.30pm for the evening to capture the magical memories. Individual and group photographs will be available to buy via the photographer's website. We will also have a Photobooth to capture more informal images throughout the evening.

The cost of a prom ticket will be £36.00 and will include a welcome drink, meal and a disco. This will need to be paid by Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May and will be visible on ParentPay from Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April. Due to the Prom being held after your child has finished their education at Lymm High School, it is a private function and is on an invitation only basis. We would like all students in Year 11 to attend; however excellent behaviour until the end of the year is essential. We reserve the right to cancel any ticket issued, at any time, without refund (this includes on the night of the Prom) if a student's behaviour and/or attitude deteriorates.
