Students will not be required to wear school uniform when attending these sessions, however they will need to bring any snacks and drinks that they may need whilst in school as the school dining room will not be open. Students are asked to access A Block only, using the main entrance. Students will need to sign in at main reception and sign out at the end of the session. Due to contractors on site, it is essential that students remain in the allocated classroom, which will be listed in Reception. There will be toilet access only in A block. Other areas of school are out of bounds due to maintenance work being carried out – please could you let your child know this; they will be reminded upon signing in.

Please note that in the interest of Safeguarding, when your child agrees to attend school in the holidays they will need to be on the school site at all times and comply with the normal school rules and regulations. If a student misbehaves, they will be sent home and the parent/carer will be contacted.
