Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to confirm arrangements for all Year 13 students as they near the end of their studies and their time at Lymm High School.

The external examination period starts for many students on the 20th May, which is much earlier than previous years. Official study leave does not start until after the May half term holiday, but we recognise that students will need some time to prepare for their exams. Therefore, where students have an exam in the morning they are allowed to take off the afternoon before their exam, and for afternoon exams, they can work from home in the morning. They are of course, welcome to attend school as usual.

Friday 24 May will be the last formal day for Year 13 students and they will be expected to attend school as usual at 8.25am. Period 1, 2 and 3 lessons will continue as normal, providing students with last minute support for their exams. Their final assembly is scheduled for 12pm, to allow those students sitting external examinations enough time to complete their exam and have their shirts signed. Students will leave school by 1pm and then they are free to enjoy the usual Lymm High Sixth Form tradition of visiting the local pub which, may I add, has nothing to do with school!

Students have chosen Statham Lodge as the venue for their Leavers' Ball and to say their final goodbyes. Tickets are **£39**, payable now on ParentPay. If students do plan to attend, it is crucial they pay for their ticket before Friday 24 May to ensure correct numbers are secured with the hotel. The Ball will take place on **Thursday 4 July 2018** starting at 7.00pm. It will finish at 11.00pm and includes a welcome drink, a three course meal and a disco in a beautiful private function room with its own bar and garden. If your son/daughter wishes to attend this fantastic event, please complete the attached medical consent form and permission slip and return them to Sixth Form Student Services by Friday 24 May. I know that students will consider this a little excessive, as they are old enough to do as they please now, but as this is a school event I am sure you appreciate its necessity and I thank you in advance for your support with this.

We have been delighted with how hard students have worked in the build up to exams and we really do appreciate your support with this. I know they have felt we have nagged them and I'm sure you have too, please continue to do so! They are a remarkable group of young people who collectively possess a multitude of talents of which we should all be very proud. We wish them all
