Important Sports Day Information

Our annual sports day is scheduled to take place on **Wednesday 10th July** (weather permitting). On Wednesday, the field events (throws and jumps), the 1500m and 800m track events, take place between periods 1-2. Only competitors will be out of lessons during these times. Normal lessons will go ahead periods 1-3 with break time at 10.45am.

The whole school will be out on the school field for Wednesday from 11.15am onwards. All students should register at their normal Period 3 lesson before making their way to the track area to sit in their designated hall space. Lunchtime takes place between 1.15pm and 2.10pm. All staff and students should register at

their Period 5 lesson before promptly make their way to the track for the remaining events, finishing at 3.10pm.

During the day, all students, whether competing or not, must arrive to school in PE kit. Blue tracksuit bottoms can be worn along with a blue top or school blazer. A white PE top, blue shorts/skorts, white socks and trainers are to be worn when competing. No hoodies or fashion tops are permitted and will be confiscated if seen.

Students should bring plenty to drink and (as we are hoping for nice weather) parents should consider supplying students with hats and sun protection for the afternoon, along with any medication if required. A provisional date, should we experience bad weather conditions has been reserved for Friday 12th July.

For safeguarding purposes, due to the large number of students and the size of the school site, unfortunately we are not able to permit relatives of students/visitors onto the school site to watch sports day. Sports Day is always a wonderful event at LHS, with students competing in their halls culminating with the announcement of Hall Champion of the Year.
