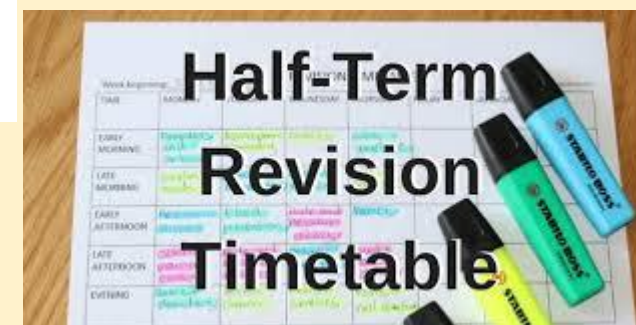
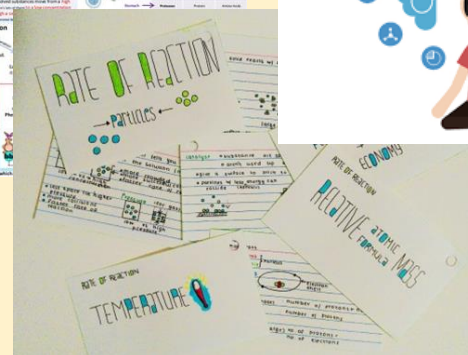
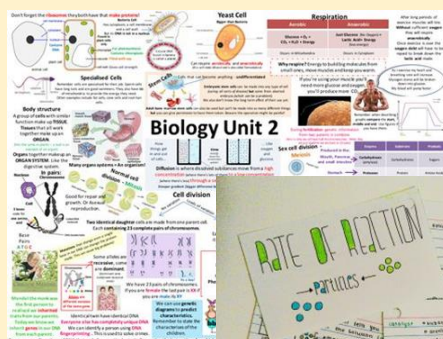
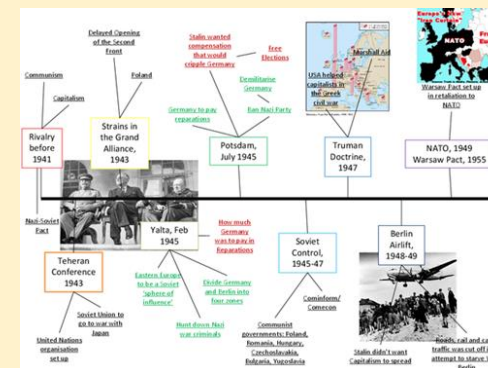
- Low-stakes testing, drilling core knowledge

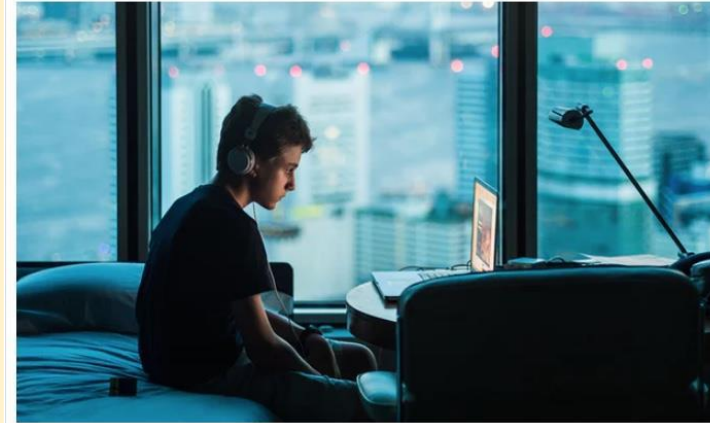
