


Ways to use Retrieval Practice

- Flash Cards but not a long time creating these
- Quick fire quiz on content
- Regular practice

Don't avoid the subjects/areas/topics that are the hardest.
Use the PLCs and RAG them to check understanding. In
English and Maths they have Smith Proformas which show
areas they need to develop in





Space out your practice over time







Ways to use Elaboration

- Take a part of the revision process
- Encourage your child to teach you something about the topic
- Paired/group revision has a role to play
- As they are revising get them to email themselves with some questions that they can address at a different point – can they pose their own question of what may come up in the exam?
- Don't accept their first answer ask them to elaborate further, can they extend their answers?
 Can they tell you what they would need to add to get to the next level/grade?





Switching between ideas while you study






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Ways to use Interleaving

- Plan a revision timetable that doesn't focus on the next exam
- Use a timer where there is an agreed amount of time before swapping onto next topic – possibly use the exam paper structure
- Start revision NOW.
- Attend the revision workshops
- Don't let them shy away from the areas which are difficult
