#### 2021 South Africa Sports Tour

Provisional dates are currently **Wednesday 21st July** returning home **Thursday 29th July**. The nine day tour will be based around Cape Town and involve Table Mountain, Robben Island, a Cape Peninsula tour and game drives searching for the 'BIG 5'.

Open to our current Year 9, 10 and 11 students, the tour will officially be launched early in September with the exact information confirmed nearer the time.

The British and Irish Lions will be touring in 2021 and we're sure the excitement in South Africa at this time will be evident in a country that is so enthusiastic about sport.

The cost is yet to be finalised but is estimated at around £2400. This includes full board and all activities planned for the duration of the tour.
