

Dear parents, carers and students,

I hope you are all well and are enjoying your half term in the sun.

From Monday 1st June we will be able to offer all Year 12 students online lessons in all of their subjects. We know many of them have already been attending online lessons and these have gone really well, but we have listened to students' comments regarding lesson clashes and as a result we are now introducing a brand-new timetable from Monday. You will notice this is only a one-week timetable instead of our usual two. This means students can access every lesson and there will no longer be any lesson clashes.

Students have been sent the timetable below and have been asked to check when their lessons will run. They will know which group they are in based on their current class code and they will then need to identify when these classes are scheduled for e.g. 12c/Ec1 is on Monday P1, Tuesday P2, Wednesday P2, Thursday P1, so these periods will be their new lesson times for the foreseeable future. Once they have done this for all their subjects, they will have a new timetable to work from.

Lessons will be held on Microsoft Teams and students should all be familiar with logging onto these now. I would advise asking your son/daughter to show you they can log on and access the relevant teams before Monday. Students have been sent a help video and can always contact me if they have any queries.

It is really important for me to clarify that these lessons are compulsory, so students must attend them. If there is something stopping them attending, please let me know and I will see what I can do to help. As I clarified last week, part time jobs should not take priority over their studies.

It is also worth asking your son/daughter to show you the 2019-Year 12 Microsoft Teams page as this has a huge variety of different online events provided by universities / apprenticeships which students can take part in. These range from subject specific sessions to help with personal statements, finance and much more. This page also includes a video step by step UCAS guide and we have asked students to complete all sections (apart from their final personal statement and their choices) by 15th June. I am delighted so many of them have logged on and already have this completed!

If students are confused about which lesson they should attend, they should email me or contact the relevant Head of Faculty. Likewise, as we move forward to offering online lessons to most subjects, the Head of Faculty will be your first port of call if you are experiencing difficulties accessing lessons or finding your lesson.
