**LYMM HIGH SCHOOL GUIDANCE: GCSE RESULTS DAY 2020
GCSE RESULTS DAY –THURSDAY 20 AUGUST 2020 (FROM 8.30AM)**

GCSE Results Day will run as originally planned on Thursday 20 August. We are giving students the option to either come into school to collect their results at 8:30 or 9.00am (dependant on surname) or receive them via email. **Students must email exams@lymmhigh.org.uk by 31 July 2020 if they wish for their results to be sent via email.**

The collection of results will look different from previous years as we must consider the current social distancing guidelines set by the Government, especially when hosting such an important day.

To maintain safe social distancing, we are implementing the following safety measures:

- 1 Providing staggered times and locations to ensure that a limited number of students are on site at one time – see detailed information below. We must also insist that anyone who has coronavirus symptoms, or who has someone in their household with symptoms, does not attend school to collect their results.
- 2 Requesting that all parents/carers remain in their cars/off site, as we cannot allow them onto the school premises. We understand this is not ideal, but we feel it is necessary to reduce the number of people present on site at one time. We ask that parents/carers do not gather at entrance gates or doors or enter our school site unless they have a prearranged appointment.
- 3 Implementing a one-way system that also ensures students are given the opportunity to talk to the relevant staff in a support room, if they are worried about their results.
- 4 Providing hand sanitiser upon arrival. We also ask that students bring their own pens as they will be required to sign for their results. **They must also wear a face covering.**
- 5 Staff responsible for preparing results will wear the appropriate PPE.
- 6 Sixth form enrolment will be electronic this year. Students will receive details in their results envelope and via email to explain how this will work.

*Please note, all Year 10 English Literature results and any Year 12/13 students receiving GCSE resit results will have these emailed directly to their school email account at 11.00am. Year 10 students are advised to see the separate letter from Mrs Feast **here**.

See below for details of where students will receive their results. Please also look carefully at the maps attached, as these will show you which entrance and exits students must use on the day. Results will ONLY be available during the time slots below.

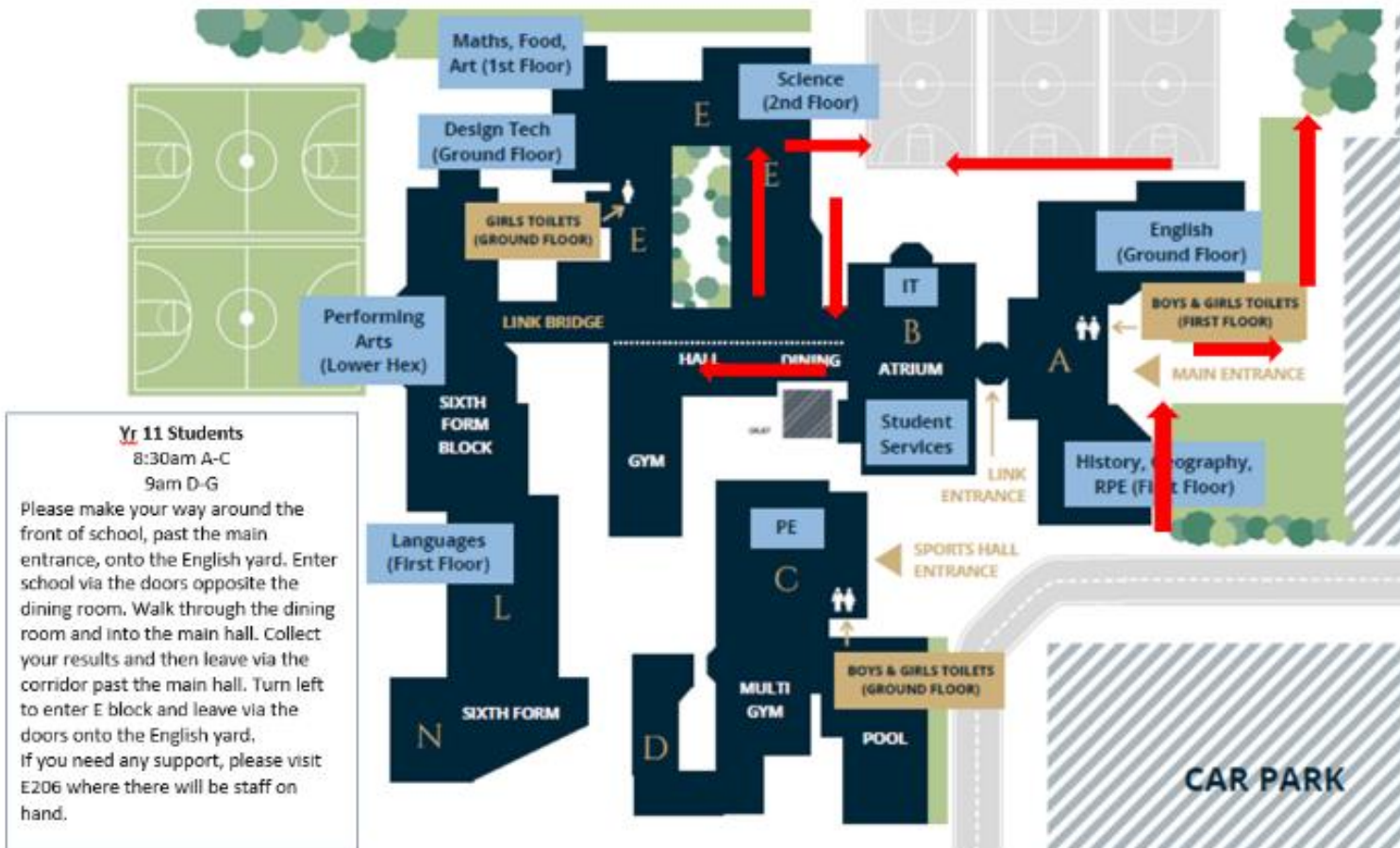
