LYMM HIGH SCHOOL GUIDANCE: A' LEVEL RESULTS DAY 2020
A' LEVEL RESULTS DAY – THURSDAY 13 AUGUST 2020 (FROM 8.00AM)

A' level results day will run as originally planned on Thursday 13 August. We are giving students the option to either come into school to collect their results in person from 8.00am, or receive them via email. **Students must email exams@lymmhigh.org.uk by 31 July 2020 if they wish for their results to be sent via email.**

The collection of results will look different from previous years as we must consider the current social distancing guidelines set by the Government, especially when hosting such an important day.

To maintain safe social distancing, we are implementing the following safety measures:

- 1 Providing staggered locations to ensure that a limited number of students are in one area at one time – see detailed information below. We must also insist that anyone who has coronavirus symptoms, or who has someone in their household with symptoms, does not attend school to collect their results.
- 2 Requesting that all parents/carers remain in their cars/off site to keep numbers of people on site to a minimum. We understand this is not ideal, but we feel it is necessary. We ask that parents/carers do not gather at entrance gates or doors or enter our school site unless they have a prearranged appointment.
- 3 Implementing a one-way system that also ensures students are given the opportunity to talk to the relevant staff in a support room, if they are worried about their results.
- 4 Providing hand sanitiser upon arrival. We also ask that students bring their own pen as they will be required to sign for their results. Students must also wear a face covering.
- 5 Ensuring that staff responsible for preparing the results will wear the appropriate PPE.

Please see below for details of where students will be given their results. Please also look carefully at the maps attached, as these will show which entrances and exits students must use on the day.
