
Regional average wages per job are £1.7k below the national average wages of £30.0k per job.

- The top three industries in 2019 are Accounting, bookkeeping and auditing activities; tax consultancy, Temporary employment agency activities, and Hospital activities.








Job Trends




Millennials

Racial diversity is low in Warrington. The national average for an area this size is 31,232 racially diverse people, while there are 9,754 here.










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ





Top Industry GVA


2016 Gross Value Added






Top Industry Wages

2019 Wages Per Worker


















