Dear Parent/Carer

We have been delighted to see students returning to school and we are equally impressed with how well they have settled back into routine. School continues to operate within the same safety measures we introduced in September, such as split lunches and the one-way system around school, all of which will remain in place until the end of this academic year. Whilst we have deliberately been a little more lenient with regards to one or two uniform issues over the past couple of weeks since lockdown ended, we feel it is now time to remind students of the high standards we set ourselves at Lymm High School and we would welcome your support with this.

When students return to school after Easter we will expect all students to wear the correct school uniform, this includes:

- Shoes – no trainers/trainer-style footwear
- Coats and not hoodies – students can wear a coat to school, but with the warmer months ahead, they should not need to wear these in classrooms or in corridors. Students should not wear hoodies to school.
- No visible jewellery including any piercings
- Discreet make-up; no false nails, clear nail varnish only; eyebrows and eyelashes should be natural
- Hair should be neat and conventional with no extremes of style/colour. No haircuts shorter than a grade 2.
