

# Mass Testing Plan

Thursday 4th and Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March



## Key questions

- Students can only be tested if written consent has been given. If they arrive without consent they will not be able to be tested.
- If a student has tested positive within the previous 90 days they should not complete the test. They should only start testing once the 90-day period is completed. They will still be able to return to school on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March.
- If a student has been vaccinated they should still test, the vaccine will not show on the tests.
- If a student tests positive they must isolate for 10 full days following the positive test. Close contacts will also have to self-isolate for the same period.

#### General notes

- Non-uniform on Thursday/Friday for mass testing.
- Coat you will be queuing outside, so make sure you are prepared for this with appropriate clothing.
- Face mask when you enter the building you will need to put your face mask on. You will remove it in order to take the test.
- Consent Your parents/carers must have given consent. We have this information already, but any issues
  we will sort out on the day.
- Social distancing please remember to socially distance when waiting and queuing.
- Behaviour as always we expect the highest standards of behaviour. We are testing a large number of students so you need to make sure you follow instructions and behave appropriately at all times. This isn't the time to have fun with your friends, that can wait until social time when we're back in school.
- No hanging around afterwards we have lots of students exiting and arriving at school and need to keep everything flowing. You cannot hang around for friends.
- The country is still in lockdown you should not arrange to hang around with friends or in groups before/after the test. The current laws are still in place regarding meeting other people, therefore you should not be hanging around in groups before or after the test. You have to take your responsibilities as a socially responsible citizen seriously.



#### The plan

- When arriving on site, you will be directed onto the English yard and around the outside of the building. See next slide.
  - The members of staff on each yard will be sending a few students at a time to the next yard. This is so that we don't have too many students bunching in one area at a time. When you are waiting or queuing you should socially distance and wait patiently to be told when to go to the next yard.
  - When you reach the back of the sports hall you will be sent through one of two doors by a member of staff depending on your surname. A to J through one door and K to Z through the other. You will need to put on a facemask before entering.







#### The plan

- Once inside we will check your name on the list and you will be given a card with your name and a barcode.
- You will then go to one of the swabbing stations. You should blow your nose using one of the tissues provided, then sanitise your hands using the sanitiser provided. You will then open the swab from the packet. You will then need to swab each tonsil for 5 seconds (there is a mirror to help), and using the same swab you will swab one nostril (10 seconds). Staff will be on hand to support and to clean the station in between. See the next slides for further guidance.
- Once you have taken the swab put all other rubbish in the bin provided, but keep hold of the completed swab.
- Take the completed swab to the testing desk in front of you and follow the instructions given by the tester. They will ask you to put the card on the desk and the swab in one of the vials (test tubes).
- You should then leave the testing room out of the nearest door in front of you and exit the leisure Centre.
