Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Yr13 Leavers' Prom and Last day

I am writing to confirm arrangements for all Year 13 students as they near the end of their studies and their time at Lymm High School. It has been an eventful two years and the lockdowns and school closures make it feel somehow too soon to be saying goodbye. I know many of our students are now ready to take that next step and as sad as that may make us, we really are looking forward to giving them the send-off they deserve, restrictions allowing!

As you aware, students will sit two assessment windows, the first week commencing 26th April and the second week commencing 17th May. During the duration of these two weeks only, students will be allowed to study from home, they are of course welcome to use our facilities to study in school too. You can find the assessment timetables [here](#), students have also been given their own personalised copy which also provides any details of access arrangements. From Monday 24th May students are no longer required to attend school, unless this has been specified by their teacher as there may be a handful of instances where this may apply. On Friday 28th May we will arrange students a proper last day and leavers assembly, restrictions allowing. Students will be able to get their shirts signed and they will leave school by 12:15pm.

Our Prom will be held on Thursday 8th July at Statham Lodge and this will allow our students to say their final goodbyes. Tickets are **£43**, payable now on ParentPay, students currently eligible for the bursary will have their ticket paid for, please see Mrs Wedgwood on Student Services to arrange this. If students do plan to attend, it is crucial they pay for their ticket before Friday 21st May to ensure correct numbers are secured with the hotel. The prom starts at 7.00pm and finishes at 11.00pm and the price includes a welcome drink, a three-course meal and a disco in a beautiful private function room with its own bar and garden. If your son/daughter wishes to attend this fantastic event, please complete this [medical consent form](#) and permission slip (below) and return them to Sixth Form Student Services by Friday 21st May. I know that students will consider this a little excessive, as they are old enough to do as they please now, but as this is a school event I am sure you appreciate its necessity and I thank you in advance for your support with this.

We have been delighted with how hard students have worked in the build up to their assessments and we really do appreciate your support with this. I know they have felt we have nagged them and I'm sure you have too, please continue to do so! They are a remarkable group of young people who collectively possess a multitude of talents of which we should all be very proud. We wish


