Face coverings

The big news this week surrounds face coverings. You may have seen that the government has changed its guidance such that students will no longer need to wear them in school at all (neither in classrooms or communal areas) from Monday 17th May. If your child wishes to continue to wear a face covering at any point, then they are very welcome to – but, from Monday, they will no longer be required to do so. The only exception to this is on the use of public transport, so <u>please make sure that your child still wears a face</u> <u>covering if they use the school bus</u>. Staff will have to continue wearing face coverings when moving around the building and in communal areas, but will no longer need to wear them in lessons. We understand that not everybody will be in agreement with this move at this time but, equally, we suspect most will agree that this represents another very welcome step towards normality.

Interhall Sport Events

I am delighted to say that we will be running an Interhall Sport event for Years 7, 8 and 9 next week ($w/c 17^{th}$ May).

The girls will be taking part in a cricket tournament and the boys will be doing football.

It will require students coming off their normal timetable at certain points – as shown below:

- Monday 17th May: Year 7 (P1–4)

On their specified day students will need to attend school wearing their PE kit. Boys - Football

Hopefully, the sun will shine; however, if the weather is extremely wet, we may have to postpone the event and students will attend their normal lessons. Students should bring their normal books/equipment just in case this occurs.
