Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Yr 11 Leavers' Prom and Last day

After what has been a very challenging year for our current Year 11s, we wanted to congratulate them on their hard work, dedication and the resilience that they have shown, particularly over this final period of assessments. We are really looking forward to celebrating their time with us and giving them the send-off they deserve. Therefore, it gives me great pleasure to share our plans for both Leavers and the much-anticipated Year 11 prom.

It has been difficult to confirm a date with the venue, due to the uncertainty of the government's roadmap, and how restrictions may/may not be lifted. Therefore, as I am sure you will understand, we have had to proceed with caution, doing all we can to secure a date whilst ensuring that payment will not be lost in the event that restrictions are not lifted in line with the current government plans.

After weeks of discussions, we can now confirm that the Year 11 Prom will be held on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> July at The Courthouse in Knutsford. Tickets are £40 in total which will include a welcome drink on arrival, a three-course meal and a disco in a beautiful private function room with its own garden. As all of you have already paid a £10 deposit, the remaining £30 is payable now on ParentPay. If students do plan to attend, it is crucial they pay for their ticket before Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June and submit their medical form to ensure correct numbers are secured with the venue. Students will be able to start arriving from 6.30pm and will need to be collected by parents/carers no later than 10.00pm. If your son/daughter wishes to attend this fantastic event, and has not already sent in their details, please complete the attached medical consent form and permission slip and return them to the school shop by, Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June.

If we feel that a student's behaviour is unacceptable before or during the event, we do reserve the right to ask parents to collect their child. We do hope that our Year 11s would not spoil their prom night by arriving under the influence of alcohol or any other banned substance, or indeed having it on their persons. If this is the case, we will contact parents/carers to collect their child.

As we are in Knutsford, it is imperative that students are picked up from The Courthouse. We will be there until all students are safely collected, but this will be an expectation.
