Study leave

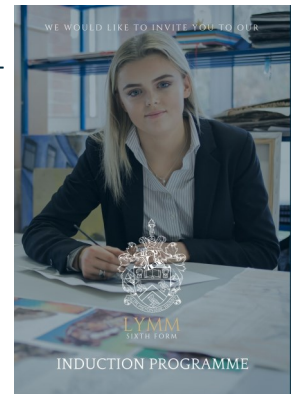
You will be given study leave for your mocks so you only need to attend for the exams you are sitting. However, please note:

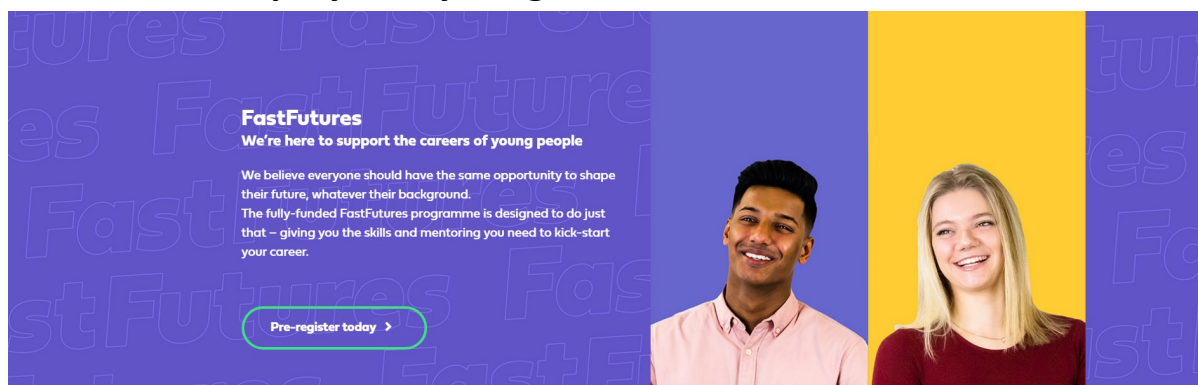
