Dear Parents/Carers,

As we approach the end of the summer term, we wanted to write to you to confirm the arrangements for GCSE results day this summer.

GCSE Results Day will take place on Thursday 12 August 2021. Students can collect their results from the Sports Hall from 8:30am, entering through the Leisure Centre main entrance. We will allow students only on site, so if you are accompanying your son/daughter to school, we kindly request you stay in your vehicles. Parking will be available on both the Sixth Form car park and the Leisure Centre car park.

Staff, including our careers advisor, will be on hand in the Library should students require additional support. Parents will also be able to meet with Sixth Form staff where there are queries with regards to enrolment. Students have already had an assembly explaining the format of the day, a recording of which can be found in the '6th Form Transition 2021 Team'. We advise that students watch this again before results day, as this will provide some helpful reminders. If students are not going to collect their results in person, they must email examsresults@lymmhigh.org.uk to arrange for their results to be sent via email.

On results day, all students will receive an email which will allow us to capture their destinations and process enrolment to our Sixth Form. Students who have applied to join us in the Sixth Form will receive a copy of their current Sixth Form offer in their results envelope. All enrolment will take place online this year; a link will be provided to students' emails on the morning of results day and students will only need to meet with a member of the Sixth Form team if they have not met the conditions of their offer. Where a meeting is needed, please be prepared to attend an appointment later in the day. In the event that a student wishes to change their course choices, providing they meet the entry requirements (a copy of these will be given on results day), this can also be done using the online form and without the need to meet a member of the Sixth Form team.
