


National Trust car park, so free for members; otherwise pay and display.</p>
<p>Camp Night 1</p>	<p>Hardhurst Farm Campsite Hope Valley S336RB</p> <p>What 3 Words momentous.logic.posting</p>		<p>From Cheshire your likely approach to Hardhurst is via Castleton and Hope on the A6187. To access the camp site, turn left at Brough, approx. 2.5 miles east of Castleton</p>
<p>Camp Night 2</p>	<p>Newfold Farm Campsite Grindsbrook Booth Hope Valley S33 7ZD</p> <p>What 3 Words dozens.blazing.coasting</p>		<p>Newfold Farm campsite is located north of Edale station. Follow the lane past a campsite on the right and the church on the left. The campsite is the next left turn.</p>
<p>Finish</p> <p>Finishing window between: 14.30 - 15.30</p>	<p>Hayfield Countryside Centre Station Road Hayfield SK22 2ES</p> <p>What 3 Words difficult.savers.laptops</p>		<p>The visitor's centre is located just north of the junction between the A6015 with the A624 in Hayfield. Parking and toilets are available. This is a pay and display car park.</p>
