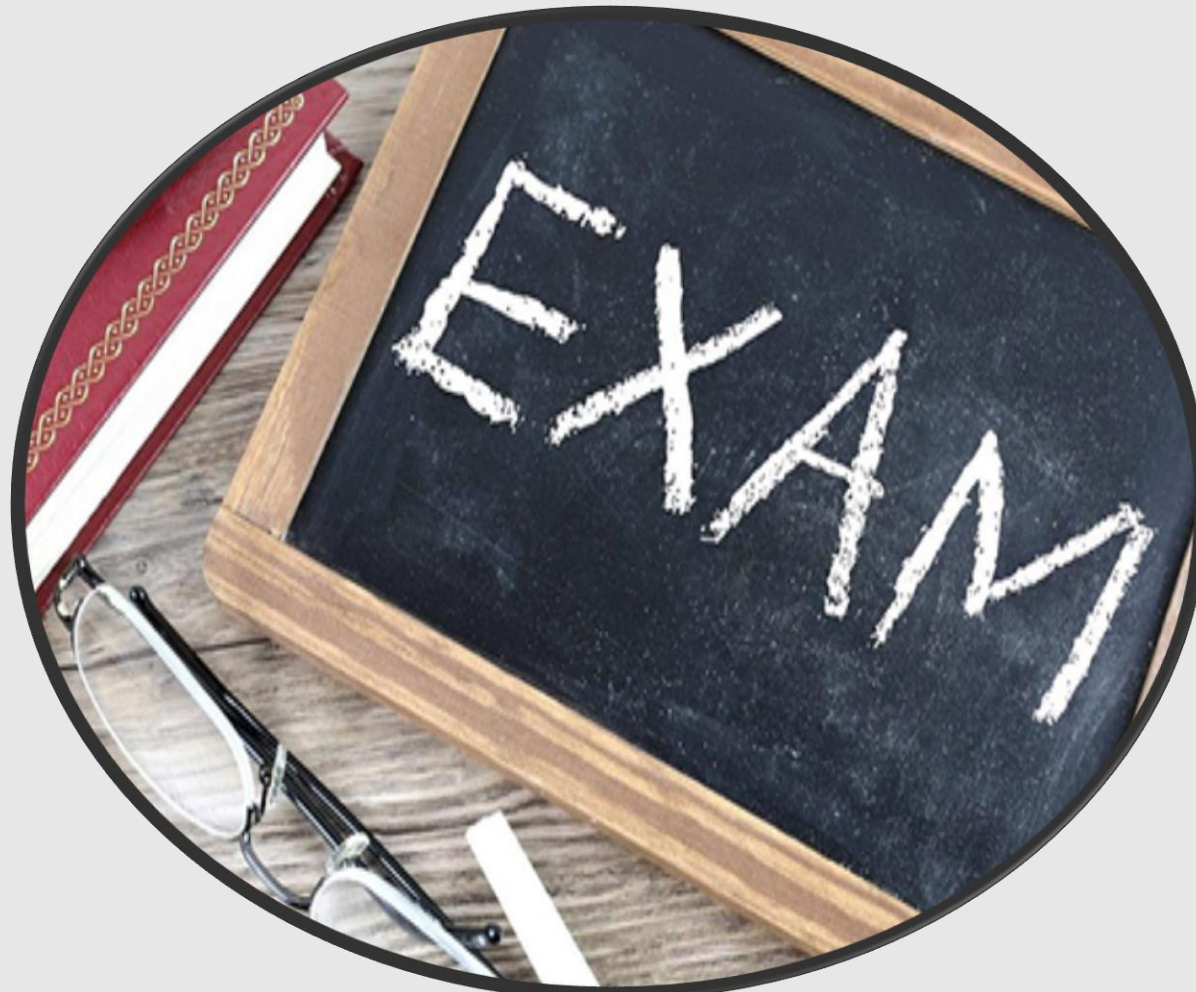

Exam etiquette

Timetable

You should have now received your exam timetable.

- Check the room, make sure you know where you are going ahead of the exam
- Make sure you know your seat number, as this will be checked!
- TIMES OF EXAMS
 - AM – exam starts @ 8:45am. You MUST be at the exam venue at 8:30am
 - PM – exam starts @ 1pm. You MUST be at the exam venue at 12:45pm
 - Access arrangements – if you have any concerns, please come and see someone ASAP

Equipment – what do you need?

- Black ball point pen (and several spares!)
- Pencil
- Calculator
- Ruler
- Highlighters
- All in a CLEAR plastic pencil case
- Water bottle – in a clear bottle with NO label
- You are NOT allowed to wear a smart watch – these MUST be in your bags
- Mobile phones – BANNED from the exam venue. These must be switched off and in your bag





In the exam venue

- The invigilators word is the law!
- Follow all instructions
- Do not talk or communicate with anyone
- Raise your hand if you need to ask a question
- Check you can see the clock
- No food is allowed
- Leave in silence, others may still be working
- No toilet breaks!
- Extra paper – label it!

If you are a clash candidate

- You will be kept in isolation
- You will not be able to use your mobile phone
- The invigilator will be present at all times
- You are allowed to revise, bring written notes only, you will not have access to online apps etc
- You **MUST** bring your own food / snacks
