Dear Parents/Carers,

As we approach the end of the summer term, we wanted to write to you to confirm the arrangements for GCSE Results Day this summer.

GCSE Results Day will take place on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022. Students can collect their results from the Sports Hall from 9.00am. It is worth noting that over the summer, extensive works are taking place on the **main school** / leisure centre car park, so both the car parks and the main school entrance will be closed. Entrance to the school site will only be available through the sixth form entrance, with very limited parking available on the sixth form car park; please do walk to school if you are able to. To access the Sports Hall, students will walk through the McCombs yard and into the leisure centre entrance, this is the only way the leisure centre can be accessed. Once their results have been collected, they will leave the Sports Hall through the back stairs. Only students will be allowed into the school building, so if you are accompanying your child to school, we kindly request you stay in your vehicles or wait on the languages yard.

On GCSE Results Day, students will receive an email with an online link which they all MUST complete. This form will enable students to enrol with us in the sixth form, or, if they are moving onto another college/apprenticeship, their destination will be recorded on this form. The Sixth Form team will be on hand to support students in the Lower Hexagon, should there be any queries regarding their chosen subjects. Once students have completed this online form, they will receive confirmation of their enrolment by Monday 29<sup>th</sup> August.

There will be a number of staff present on the day, including our careers advisor and members of the pastoral team, who will be on hand in the Lower Hexagon should students require additional support. We know that this can be a difficult time for some, and <u>attached here</u> is some information regarding well-being support for your child.
