In addition, we have been telling students to avoid running around too vigorously in the direct sun, and to seek shade under the trees on the field at break and lunch. On very rare occasions in the past we have allowed students to wear PE kit but this is generally only when there is a prolonged period of extreme heat and not for the odd hot day here or there, or else we get into an unhelpful debate about when precisely PE kit can be worn every time the forecast is for warmer weather.
