Hot weather

Founders' Day

We are very much looking forward to our Founders' Day celebrations on **Wednesday 20th July**, being particularly excited for our first ever sponsored Colour Run! Here are a couple of key messages to ensure the smooth running of the day:

- Students may wear sports clothing, but as we have said before, please ensure that this is old and not brand new as it will be getting covered in powdered paint during the Colour Run (Please see <u>FAQs here</u>). Please also ensure that clothing is appropriate for school (i.e., no crop tops or shorts which are particularly short in length).
- Students should bring a spare T-Shirt to pop on to travel home on the buses.
- Students will spend the day taking part in various activities including: a celebration assembly, reflection on the school year, well-being activities and learning about the history of our school.
- Students should bring a refillable water bottle with them, and ensure that they have anything else they require such as a raincoat, suitable trainers, sun cream/hat if applicable.
- Students may bring sunglasses/goggles with them to wear during the Colour Run.

It is worth noting, that as you may have seen from the weather forecast, there is a likely chance of rain on Wednesday. We will have a contingency plan.

A huge thank you for those donations already received, it is wonderful to see how our students and families are supporting charity within our local community.
