
An Oxford University researcher will join the MUN Club next year to study how classroom activities help educate students about global governance. Please let Miss J Dixon know if you are interested in taking part.

"The students were happy to take charge and had the Year 6s lined up in forms, ready to go at the end of lunch time without being asked!"




