Social media rumours

It has come to our attention that there have been some rumours going around this week on social media, mainly amongst Year 7 parents and carers, related to alleged incidents inside and outside of school. It seems some of these rumours are of a serious nature and have, understandably, caused concern. Whilst we totally understand why some people may appreciate explicit reassurance from school in such cases, we'd like to remind everyone that we almost never comment on rumours of this sort. This is for lots of reasons – partly to do with confidentiality issues – but also because commenting on one incident quickly sets up unrealistic expectations that we will provide a running commentary on any given incident. Also, because we can rarely provide the full picture when individuals are involved, we run the risk that giving partial information simply prompts more worries and more rumours. We are often very tempted to respond (whether that be to reassure parents or to provide a more balanced view of events where the school is being criticised) but we are sure most of you will appreciate why it is generally not sensible to do so.

Our central message is always the same: please resist the temptation to pay too much attention to what you hear or read that hasn't come directly from the school and please do <u>contact us directly if you have any concerns</u>. The issue this week is very typical of this kind of thing in that most of the rumours we've been made aware of seem to be wildly inaccurate and, certainly with the more serious elements, completely false. Please know that we would always keep parents informed if an incident was serious enough to warrant doing so; otherwise, it is generally a sound assumption that the social media rumour mill has quickly run out of control.
