Year 12 students will be able to collect their GCSE Exam certificates from Student Services on the following days at break time only:


- Tuesday – Arley and Dunham






Applications for the free online King's College London Medicine and Dentistry Lecture Series 2023 are now open. Residential Insight into University summer schools run over 4 or 5 days where students get a taster of university life and an insight into a specific STEM subject. Army Bursaries available to fund university



With Army Bursaries, students have the opportunity to fund their university undergraduate degree with a career that makes a difference. The cost of university can be prohibitive, but the Army has various ways to help your students fund their education. This is what students could get while studying:

- **Undergraduate bursary** – Standard: £6000 throughout their course
- **Defence STEM Undergraduate Sponsorship (DSUS) Scheme:** Worth £42,750
- **Undergraduate bursary** – Enhanced (AUBE): Up to £24,000
- **Medical bursaries** – Medical, Veterinary, Dental, Nursing students and Soldier student nurses: Up to £75,000 for studying and training
- **Music bursaries:** Up to £9250 sponsorship
- **Officer fully-funded degree:** A fully funded BSc in Leadership and Strategic Studies with the Army
- **Internships:** Develop leadership skills with the army. This can be for students looking to take a gap year before university (£18,000+)
