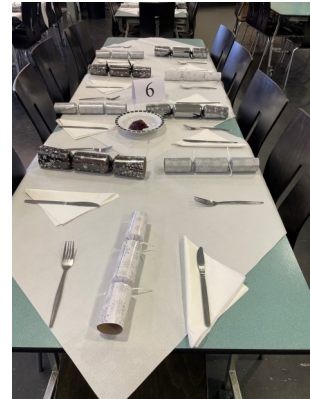

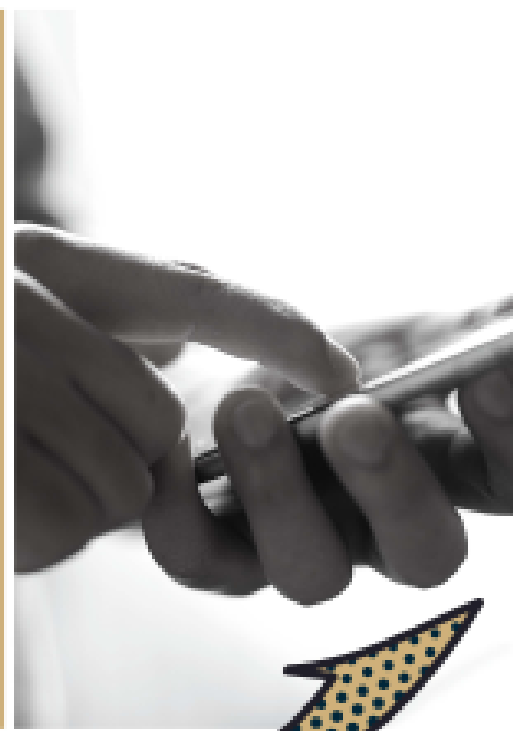
Christmas Dinner

Roast turkey (or Quorn) with all the trimmings was served to Year 12 and 13 students on **Tuesday 13th December** by the Sixth Form staff.






