Life Programme

- Year 7 have been working on keywords and concepts linked to prejudice and rights. They will look at the demographic make up of Warrington and Lymm and discuss strategies to encourage inclusion and community spirit.
- Year 8 have been looking back at consent and considering what the law states consent to be. This builds from the introduction to consent they had in Year 7 and begins to consider what consent may look like in romantic relationships. Lessons include age-appropriate scenarios to help students work through contemporary issues.
- Year 9 have also been looking at consent and the factors that affect a person's capacity to consent. They will evaluate the impact of peer pressure, alcohol and drug taking on different scenarios.
