Strike action

Teacher strikes are taking place on **Wednesday 15**th and **Thursday 16**th **March**. The number of staff taking part in the action means that we will not be able to open to all year groups on these days. Therefore:

- On **Wednesday 15**th **March**, school will be open as normal to Years 7, 9, 11, 12 and 13. There may be some disruption to lessons, with cover work being set, but the great majority of lessons will be unaffected for most students. Years 8 and 10 will be set work to complete at home via Show My Homework in the same way that we did last time.
- On Thursday 16th March, school will be open to Years 7, 10, 11, 12 and 13. This means Years 8 and 9 will be set work to complete at home.
