## Re: YEAR 8 RESIDENTIAL TRIP (CURRENT YEAR 7) – Conway Centre

We are all very aware that the COVID pandemic has meant Year 7 missing out on their induction trip to Tynny. Unfortunately, the impact of the prolonged closure means that we cannot be confident enough that it will be possible to get Tynny ready for such large events very soon. However, the great news is that we have managed to make alternative arrangements for a trip so that nobody will be missing out on the fantastic experience of a residential trip with their peers. I am really excited about going myself and look forward to spending time with the whole of Year 7.

The trip will be to Conway Centre where students will experience three days (two nights) in an area of outstanding natural beauty in the North Wales countryside. They will experience an immersive outdoor adventure specifically aimed at developing confidence, resilience and life skills. It promises to be a great deal of fun.

All activities will be led by the experienced Conway team and supported by staff from Lymm High School. There will be a variety of activity sessions, from water sports to fun problem-solving initiatives. Students will experience a daily programme of adventure experiences that encourage them to bond and work together as a team.

The students will be based at the Conway site for the duration of the trip. All meals are provided, and students will sleep in dormitory-style residential blocks (all bedding is provided). There is a shop on site which sells additional snack and drinks as well as souvenirs so students may wish to bring a small amount of pocket money with them.

We would really like the whole year group to access and take part in this trip. Having the opportunity to stay away from home, overnight on a school residential is a big part of growing up and will be an experience students will remember for life.

Please do not hesitate to contact school to discuss payment/support should it be required: we are very keen that no child misses out for financial reasons and we do have a fund to support families where needed.
