



RE: Year 11 GCSE Exams

Dear parents/carers,

I hope that you all enjoyed a restful Easter holiday. A big well done to the many Year 11 students who attended school over the holidays, either to a subject session or to the independent study room to complete their own revision; it has been great to see their positive work ethic and determination to succeed.

As we near the final weeks before the GCSE examinations officially commence, I understand that nerves may be setting in, with both students and parents feeling a heightened sense of pressure and worry. Whilst these feelings are completely normal at this time of year, please be assured that we have an extensive plan of support for Year 11 to continue to guide and encourage them as they navigate their way through these final few weeks.

Firstly, as mentioned in my previous letter, all Year 11 lessons will take place as normal between now and Friday 26th May as students still have key knowledge to recap and exam technique to go over with their teachers; therefore, expectations for student attendance remain as normal and attendance procedures will continue to be applied. Those final lessons, including the additional pre-exam warm up sessions before the exams are invaluable and it is vital that students do not disadvantage themselves by not attending. I have attached a copy of the bespoke plan of where and when these additional sessions will be taking place. It is also worth reminding you that the revision timetable for morning, lunchtime and afterschool sessions will continue to run as normal this half term too. It can be [found here](#).

Secondly, from Monday 5th June, we will be giving Year 11 students the option of only attending school for their scheduled exams. However, in order to provide more bespoke and structured support for our students throughout the entirety of the exam period, we will also continue to deliver additional 'final top tips' sessions and pre-exam briefings both in the mornings and afternoons to best prepare Year 11, helping them to feel more confident and motivated.

For all exams commencing at 8.45am, all students sitting that exam should attend the Main Hall from 8.15am for an 'Exam Warm Up'. This will be led by either the Subject Leader or Head of Faculty and will offer some final top tips in exam technique. Subject staff will also attend these sessions to help answer any last-minute queries or to simply offer pastoral support and calm nerves, before walking students over to the exam hall. This offer will continue throughout the entire exam period with attendance being compulsory as registration for the exam will also be taking place. I really hope that we can work together to ensure that students take advantage of all that is on offer to them throughout the exam period.
