Gateway app

You have probably noticed that the information on students' hall points or behaviour points on the Gateway app has changed and doesn't currently say who has awarded the points or for what reason. The reason for this is that we are trialling a new app in school, with the aim of rolling it out to parents and carers as soon as we are confident everything is working as it should. The new app will include all the relevant information (indeed, it will provide you with more information and a better experience all round) but unfortunately technical reasons mean that the Gateway app will only show very basic details whilst we are in the transition period. We anticipate launching the new app around about October half-term. Many thanks for your patience with this.

Access to Satchel One for homework

Parents of Year 7 students

Year 7 parents should now have received emails advising them of their child's unique PIN for Satchel One and how to use this to log-in and view homework tasks. This email will also include parent codes to allow access to their child's account. As all homework is set on this platform, it is important that students have access. Homework will be set for Year 7 students as follows:

- From **Monday 18th September**, homework will be set in core subjects (English, Maths and Science) and also Languages.
- From Monday 6th November (after half-term break), homework will be set in all subjects.

Parents of Year 8-13 students

Students in Years 8–13 can expect homework in all subjects from the start of term, and should already have access to the platform.

Existing parent users will need to 'verify' accounts for use this year, and should receive an app notification or email advising how to do this. Accounts will need to be verified before they can be used this academic year.
