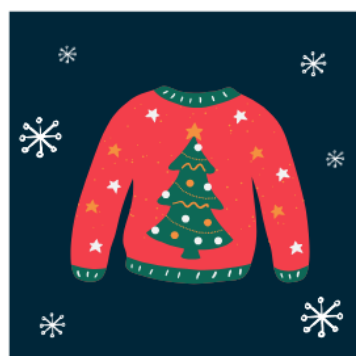

# LIFE PROGRAMME

During the Life Programme session on **Tuesday 12th December**, students will focus on the following:

## **Year 12**

### ***Sexual Harassment***

Year 12 will have Life Programme led by Mrs Jennings and Miss Dixon on the topic of Sexual Harassment. Students will be asked to consider what sexual harassment is and how it may present itself in a Sixth Form context now they are past the age of 16. 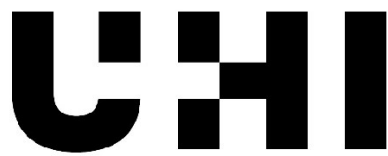
