YEAR 12 WORK EXPERIENCE

I am pleased to confirm details of the Year 12 work experience this year. All Year 12 students will have the opportunity to participate in this from Monday 24th June until Friday 28th June 2024. Work experience gives students the chance to learn about what type of job they might enjoy, and develop their CV. We know it can be one of the most transformational experiences young people have during their education.

Previous students have found most benefit from arranging their own self-placements in areas of work they are most interested in pursuing as a future career; therefore, it is the responsibility of the students to find their own placements. The work experience can be arranged online or in-person.

We are using Unifrog www.unifrog.org to manage the administration of the work experience programme which collects information from the employer about their Risk Assessment and Health & Safety policy, as well as getting agreement from yourselves for the placement to go ahead.

Some important logistics:

- Students need to agree the placement with the employer first, and then students will get the ball rolling by adding the placement to their Unifrog account (they'll find the Placements tool on their Unifrog homepage).
- The Unifrog system will then email the employer, the parent / guardian, and the school, to collect the
 necessary information and permissions. For the process to work, it's essential that students add the
 initial information about the placement accurately. If they do make a mistake, they must delete the
 placement and start a new one.

All Year 12 students have already received the essential information required to begin to allocate themselves a work experience placement. We hope that students will be able to find themselves work experience relevant and specific to their career goals and we encourage students to seek an experience that will enhance their employability in their chosen field. For students that are having difficulties with finding a self-placement, the school can provide careers guidance by making an appointment at Student Services. We also have a small database of employer contacts who have provided work experience previously, if a student really has no success finding their own placement they can come and speak to Mrs Hughes.
