- Forename
- Surname
- Address (street name, town name, postcode letters)
- Job titles
- Company names
- The first letter of a sentence





Why do we need your UCAS application so early?

- Your application will only start to be checked after you have 'PAID AND SENT' your finished application to school
- If other students have submitted their application before you, applications will be processed in the order they were sent to school
- Your application will first be checked for errors by Mrs Hughes and then read by Mr O'Flynn and Mrs Neesam
- Make sure you haven't made any of the Common Mistakes listed on this information document, otherwise this will delay your application
- If any errors are found on your application, we will send your application back to you to correct. When you resubmit it, you will go to the back of the queue for processing
