## Year 12 Work Experience

*Monday 23rd to Friday 27th June 2025*

Students are responsible for securing their own placement, ideally in an area related to your future career goals. Placements can be arranged online or in person. Once you've secured your placement, log it on Unifrog to collect necessary permissions and information. Be sure to input accurate details. If you make an error, delete and re-enter the placement.

If you need help finding a placement, book a careers guidance appointment with Student Services. We also have a list of previous employers who may offer placements.

Gold DofE students need to be aware that the work experience week coincides with your Gold DofE qualifying expedition (**25–28th June**). Please arrange your work experience for an alternative week or take part in Work Experience on **Monday 23rd and Tuesday 24th June** only.

### Key dates:

- **Now / February:** Start researching and planning your placement.
- **March and April:** Secure placement authorisation by logging it on Unifrog (without this you will not be able to go on your placement).
- **May:** Finalise placement details on Unifrog **no later than Thursday 15th May**.
- **June:** Your placement will take place during work experience week.

## Engineering at Cambridge University

17–21st February 2025

Deadline for applications: Friday 7th February 2025

Cambridge University Engineering Society's Access Week aims to dispel some of the myths around studying Engineering at Cambridge and help prospective students learn more about the application process. This unique opportunity is tailored for students from under-represented backgrounds who are interested in pursuing Engineering at Cambridge, applying in October 2025 or October 2026. The week involves a variety of sessions:

- Question form - for all potential applicants to ask questions which will be answered by current Cambridge engineering students.
- Guidance on general admission - including reformed personal statement, college selections, admission test (ESAT) and interview preparation through articles.
- A live webinar will be held for applicants to raise questions.
- Articles about Cambridge Engineering course structures.
- Introduction to Cambridge Engineering specialisations.

## Year 12 Dental Summer Schools

*Deadline to apply: Sunday 9th February 2025*

The Dental Schools Council, with funding from NHS England, are offering Year 12 students the opportunity to attend a summer school to understand what it is like to study dentistry. The four summer schools are aimed at students from under-represented backgrounds who attend a state school or college. Run by universities, the free summer schools are delivered in a variety of formats, namely residential, commuter and online.

Students will:

- Get an understanding of what it is like to study dentistry, including the different teaching methods that are used. This aims to help them consider which dental school they might want to apply to.
- Get an understanding of what the values and behaviours of dental students and dentists are.
- Get an overview of the range of dental careers available.
- Engage in activities designed to build their confidence and network with others. This includes meeting academics and university students.
- Have opportunities to discuss their options and seek advice.
- Take part in social activities.
