Re: VISIT TO EDGE HILL UNIVERSITY – Wednesday 23rd April 2025

We have organised the second of two university visits for Year 12 this year to Edge Hill University on Wednesday 23rd April 2025. Edge Hill is a campus University was rated as the 4th best University in the Northwest of England in the Complete University Guide 2025. It was also rated Gold for student experience in the 2023 Teaching Excellence Framework.

This is a fantastic opportunity for all students to gain an insight into University and experience life on campus. Whilst it is still early for students to be considering whether to attend university or take an Apprenticeship, students will have the opportunity to experience taster lectures across a variety of subjects, campus tours and workshops to support their education around the university experience. They will also have time to speak to existing students at the University about their experiences.

Students may attend in their own clothes and must register at 8.25am as normal and will return before the end of the school day at approximately 3pm. Once at the university, students will follow a programme of activities, moving round the city campus in groups, although staff will be on hand to offer support. Lunch will be **NOT** be provided on the day. Therefore, students will need to bring a packed lunch. Students may also bring money to purchase anything additional they may need.

The cost of the trip is £17 which covers the travel costs of the trip. To ensure your child can take advantage of this fantastic opportunity, please login to Parent Pay to make payment and complete the consent and medical information by no later than **Friday 14th March**. Unfortunately, we no longer accept cash payments.
