Students have set up their UCAS accounts during Form Time this week.



2025 Entrepreneurship Essay Competition

Deadline for entries: Friday 25th July

The aim of this competition from King's College Cambridge is to foster an entrepreneurial spirit among students who might not traditionally consider entering the world of business and to encourage more young people, who might not think about it, to apply to Oxbridge and Higher Education.

Students should choose between one of the three essay questions below, exploring the importance of entrepreneurism and the challenges that business-people face. This 1000-word essay should be written independently by the student but with input from a teacher or mentor.

- Q1: What makes a great business idea? Discuss how entrepreneurs can identify and evaluate opportunities for a (potentially) successful venture. Provide examples.
- **Q2:** What are the biggest challenges faced by start-ups in their early stages, and how can entrepreneurs overcome them? Provide examples.
- Q3: How do entrepreneurs build a strong team, and why is this important for a start-up's success? Provide examples.

The winner will receive a £1500 cash prize, with two runners-up prizes of £750. There will also be a number of distinguished essay commendations for those that are shortlisted (a great addition to a CV!).






