STEM Support from Cambridge University

Saturday 10th January 2026

Deadline to apply: Friday 31st October 2025

STEM SMART (Subject Mastery and Attainment Raising Tuition) is a free, 16-month programme to support students in raising their attainment at Sixth Form level and develop their confidence to apply to study physical, biological or behavioural sciences, engineering or computer science at top universities. The programme starts in the January of Year 12 and features the following three phases:

- Consolidating Knowledge and Building Problem-Solving Skills
- Preparing for Application to Competitive Universities
- Securing Strong Examination Performance and Achievement

This widening participation initiative from the University of Cambridge in association with Isaac Science provides free, complementary teaching and support to students who attend a non-fee paying school and:

- have either experienced educational disadvantage or belong to a group that is statistically less likely to progress to higher education, and
- are considering applying to Engineering, Computer Science, Physical Sciences (e.g., physics, chemistry, earth sciences, materials science) or Biological or Behavioural Sciences (e.g., plant sciences, pharmacology, physiology, evolution and behaviour, biochemistry) courses at universi-

ty and are studying A' Levels in maths and science.




