

LIFE PROGRAMME

Year 12

Year 12 students will shortly be viewing a road safety presentation entitled *Safe Drive Stay Alive* as part of our ongoing personal development and safety education.

The presentation includes a professionally produced video designed to highlight the real-life consequences of dangerous driving behaviours, particularly for young drivers and passengers. It uses realistic scenarios to reinforce key messages around road safety, decision-making and personal responsibility.

Please be aware that the video contains reconstructions of road traffic collisions and references to serious injury and loss of life. While the content is age-appropriate for KS5 students and widely used in schools nationally, some students may find parts of it emotionally impactful. Students will be supported throughout the session, and staff will be available to discuss the content and address any concerns that may arise.

If you have any questions about the presentation or wish to discuss this further, please do not hesitate to contact the school.

Year 13

Year 13 students will be taking part in a wellbeing session focused on exam stress and managing pressure. This will be delivered by our school counsellor, Ged Hindley. The session will explore the common causes of exam-related stress and anxiety, recognise how pressure can affect students emotionally and physically, and introduce practical strategies for coping with workload, revision demands and expectations. The aim is to help students develop healthy, realistic approaches to managing stress during the examination period.




