Dear parent / carer,

Re: Year 7 residential at Ty'n-y-Felin

At Lymm High School, we pride ourselves on giving all Year 7 students the opportunity to take part in a residential programme that is designed as an integral part of the Year 7 curriculum. This opportunity allows all students to continue their learning whilst staying at our wonderful outdoor education centre, Ty'n-y-Felin, on Anglesey. 'Tynny', as it's affectionately known, has been owned by the trustees of Lymm Grammar School since 1958 and is an integral part of our history and tradition. Students will have the chance to enjoy our facilities there which few schools have the opportunity to utilise and even fewer actually own. Tynny holds many special memories both for our current staff and older students as well as our 'old boys and girls' including many of you as parents, who had the opportunity to visit during your time at school.

We would like every student in Year 7 to be able to live the 'Tynny Experience'. This very special visit will be over three days and each Hall will go at a different time, with students involved in a wide range of activities including a trip to our beach Silver Bay, crabbing at the Creek, art/t-shirt painting, and a watersports activity. The cost of the visit, including the transport, accommodation, all meals and activities will be **£260**. The students will sleep in single-sex dormitories.

A coach will leave Lymm High School around 9am/9:30am on day 1 and return to school on day 3 at 3:00pm in time for the school buses. As the induction is Hall-based, both Tutor groups within each Hall will travel together. The dates are as follows:

Monday 22 June - Wednesday 24 June	Moreton Hall
Wednesday 24 June - Friday 26 June	Arley Hall
Monday 29 June – Wednesday 1 July	Dunham Hall
Wednesday 1 July – Friday 3 July	Tatton Hall
Wednesday 8 July – Friday 10 July	Walton Hall

The students will be based at 'Tynny', potentially going off site for an outdoor adventurous activity and the creek/beach and should require no further money for the trip, aside from a small amount of pocket money for snacks and souvenirs from our on-site shop (please note this is cash only).

Payment consent and medical information for the trip should be made online via ParentPay and each student will also need to have a completed outdoor activity consent form. There will be an option to pay the trip in full or as part of a payment plan to split the costs over the following dates:

- Deposit due by **26th March (£90)**
- Instalment 1 by **24th April (£90)**
- Balance by **21st May (£80)**

Payment and the full return of forms are required by 21st May 2026. (**Students eligible for Pupil Premium may use their trip voucher to pay off the final balance of the trip*). However please do not hesitate to contact school to discuss payment/support should it be required regarding the trip cost: we are very keen that no child misses out for financial reasons, and we do have a fund to support families where needed, whether eligible for Pupil Premium or not.

We are really looking forward to spending some time with our Year 7 students and are really excited to have them experience 'Tynny' for the first time. The trip promises to be the highlight of their first year at Lymm High School and gives them the opportunity to make new, and secure existing, friendships with their peers. This is always a really successful trip and one we know your children will thoroughly enjoy.
